# PRIX SANOFI DE RECHERCHE EN SANTE 22 Eme Edition INSTRUCTIONS TO AUTHORS

#### 1- Abstract

A structured abstract of fewer than 250 words should be provided.

The abstract should be written in the following instructions:

A maximum of 250 words, Police: Times roman 12, single spacing, should not include references citations.

## 2- Medical Article (Text)

The article (text) should be original related on patients care:

- Clinical investigations
- Prospective clinical trials
- Epidemiological study
- Pharmacoeconomic study ....

Original medical article must adhere to a 2.500 word limit (not including the title page, abstract, references, tables, and figures).

The final word count should be included in the title page of the manuscript. Original medical articles should be in the format of Introduction, Aim, Methods, Results, Discussion and conclusion, acknowledgments (if applicable) and references

Sanofi invites all authors to register prospective clinical trials in a suitable electronic and freely accessible registry (e.g. www.clinicaltrials.gov), and in DPM site dedicated to clinical trials.

The primary end point and power calculation must be clearly stated, and randomized clinical trials should be clearly identified as such in both the title and the abstract.

#### 3- General instructions for text

- Use a normal, plain font (e.g., 12-point Times Roman)
- Double-space the text
- Use italics for emphasis
- Use the automatic page numbering function to number the pages. Maximum of 15 pages will be accepted.
- Page numbering should begin with the title page.

## 4- Tales and figures:

Identify any previously published material by giving the original source in the form of a reference at the end of the table caption or the figure legend.

# 4-1 Tables:

- All tables are to be numbered using Arabic numerals
- Tables should always be cited in text in consecutive numerical order
- The table title should explain clearly and concisely the components of the table, it should be centered above the table.

# 4-2 Figure:

- All figures are to be numbered using Arabic numerals
- Include explanations of symbols and shading within the figure, use arrows to identify particular areas of interest.
